- **Competency and experience requirements**
 - Good, practical skills in English and courage to use them in multi-cultural settings.
 - Elementary knowledge on business and entrepreneurship.
 - Preferably 2nd or 3rd year BBA student or equivalent (over 60 ECTS credits).
- **Profile**
 - Outgoing, curious and positive personality
 - Enough maturity to operate in real-life business settings
 - Enough self-initiative and ability to manage oneself without extensive predetermined structures (such as micro-detailed curriculum)
 - Hungry to learn (internally motivated, low need for external motivation)
 - Willingness to challenge oneself both in action (such as projects) and social situations (such as working with others different from oneself).
